Games Rules

- a) On Match days you are only permitted to bring the following number of players with you to a tournament. 5 a-side total 8 players, 6 a-side total 9 players. Substitutions are a roll on roll of basis and you may repeat subs as many times as you wish.
- b) A kick off is taken from the centre spot at the start of the game and after each goal has been scored. Opponents of the kick must be 3m away from the ball.
- c) A goal **MAY NOT** be scored directly from a start or restart of play.
- d) When a ball is put out of play on the side-lines it may be thrown OR rolled in.
- e) When a ball is put out of play on the goal line by the defending team a corner will be awarded to the attacking team.
- f) When a ball is put out of play on the goal line by the attacking team a goal throw or roll will be awarded to the defending team.
- g) The ball may be played at overhead height.
- h) **ONLY** the "Keeper" is allowed in the penalty area.
- i) If an attacking player plays the ball in the opponent's penalty area a **free kick** is awarded to the defending team.
- j) If a defending player plays the ball in the penalty area a **penalty** kick is awarded to the attacking team.
- k) The "keeper" may **ONLY** throw or roll the ball.
- l) The ball may be passed back to the keeper
- m) **ALL** free kicks (with the exception of penalties) will be taken as **INDIRECT**; defenders must retreat 3m from the place of the free kick.
- n) Referees will assist deaf players by using a flag to indicate decisions **in addition** to blowing the whistle. On hearing a whistle non-deaf players should stand still.
- o) If a player with a frame **purposefully** receives, touches or intercepts the ball during open play, he / she will be allowed **10 seconds** to play the ball without being challenged by an opponent. If the ball hits or is deflected onto the frame or the player that will NOT be deemed as purposeful contact.
- p) A team may play short and the score recorded. A team may borrow players to make up the designated number but the result will be recorded as a 1 -0 win to the team with a full complement of players. (Adults & UNDER 16 ONLY)
- q) At the end of the match it is the team manager's responsibility to ensure that the referee properly records the result. **There will be no post tournament appeal.**
- r) NO Slide Tackling is permitted
- s) Goal Keeper is not allowed out of the area during the match.
